

ACCESSIBILITY RESOURCES: TEST ADMINISTRATIONS COMPARISON

This document provides a reference for implementation of the accessibility resources for the 2023-2024 test administration. Tables listing the Universal Tools, Designated Supports, and Accommodations show any updates that were made to a resource following the 2022-2023 Test Administration.

There is a table for each category of Accessibility Resources. Each table identifies whether a given resource was available for the 2022-2023 test administration and is available for the 2023-2024 test administration. Each table also includes details on the updates to the implementation of a given accessibility resource. Updates are in highlighted cells within each table. Full descriptions of the accessibility resources are found in the *Usability, Accessibility, and Accommodations Guidelines*. Brief definitions are available here:

- ▶ Universal tools are accessibility resources that are available to participating students, based on student preference and selection.
- ▶ **Designated supports** are those features that are available for use by **any student** for whom the need has been indicated by an educator or team of educators with parent/guardian and student.
- Accommodations are changes in procedures or materials that increase equitable access during the Smarter Balanced assessments by generating valid assessment results for students who need them and allowing these students to show what they know and can do. Smarter Balanced members have identified digitally-embedded and non-embedded accommodations for students for whom there is documentation of the need for the accommodations in an Individualized Education Program (IEP) or 504 plan.

		Updated verbiage (Recommendations for Use): "Word prediction allows students to begin writing a word and choose from a list of single words that have been predicted from word frequency and syntax rules. Word prediction is delivered via a non-embedded software program. The program must use only single word prediction. Functionality such as phrase prediction, predict ahead, or next word will be unavailable."
